EBA has been chosen as VA Community Living Center designers and planners for a new state-owned VA Community Living Center in Kearney, NE. EBA will be teaming up with local architects, Wilkins Hinrichs Stober Architects of Nebraska. The project is being designed based upon the VA CLC Design Guide requirements and intent. This \$121 million facility will feature paved and lit walking trails, water features, wood and ceramic shops, a chapel, a library, landscaping, garden areas, and a new Veterans' Memorial.

### EBA Receives First GSA Schedule Contract

EBA has been awarded our first contract under the recently acquired GSA 03FAC Schedule. The project, Space Utilization Study, is for the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy in Great Neck, NY. Project services will include site surveys; field verification; data analysis; preliminary planning; programming; rate utilization review; comparative analysis; and use analysis. The Academy is in the process of expanding its enrollment and upgrading facilities. EBA is retained to assist in the projections of campus enhancements and development of planning concepts in keeping with their CIP & Mission. In addition, our task requires the development of concepts for better use of the site and building therein. 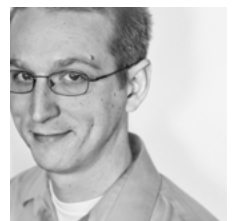
